

Guidelines for submission of Research Posters

24th International Farm Management Congress Saskatoon, Saskatchewan July 7-12, 2024

Submission Guidelines

Authors must submit an electronic version of their poster through the following submission portal https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/IFMA2024. A brief guide is provided at the end of this document, a 'Help' tab and answers to common questions are provided within the submission web pages.

The final deadline for submission of all papers is 11:59 pm CST April 14, 2024.

We look forward to receiving your research poster submission and your participation in the 24th Congress of the International Farm Management Association. Thank you for your contribution to advancing agricultural knowledge and practices.

Posters must be written in English.

For research posters, submit a 500-word abstract of what your poster will cover.

Poster submissions should include:

- I. Cover page containing the following information:
 - A. Congress sub theme followed by Title.
 - B. The author(s) names and affiliation(s). Where authors come from more than one organization, use superscript numbers to indicate their affiliation.
 - C. The name and contact details (email, phone, and postal address) of the corresponding author.
 - D. Acknowledgements (including information on grants received).
 - E. A statement that the work is all original research carried out by the authors (academic papers only).
- II. Poster Abstract would include a synopsis of the work not exceeding 500 words followed by key words (maximum 6). The synopsis should explain the purpose of the work presented in the poster as well as and the conclusions and the contribution.

Keywords – maximum 6

Guidelines for Poster Content:

Title: Provide a clear and concise title that accurately represents the focus of

your research.

Authors: Include the names and affiliations of all contributing authors. Highlight

the primary presenter.

Abstract: Present a brief summary of your research objectives, methodology, key

findings, and implications.

Introduction: Clearly state the background and objectives of your research.

Methods: Describe the methods and techniques employed in conducting your

research.

Results: Present your research findings with appropriate data visualization

techniques (e.g., graphs, charts, tables).

Analyze and interpret the results, emphasizing their significance and Discussion:

implications for farm management practices.

Summarize the main findings and implications of your research. Conclusion:

Acknowledgments: Recognize any individuals or organizations that contributed to the

research but are not listed as authors.

References: Provide a list of references cited in your poster.

Poster Design:

Design the poster layout in a clear and organized manner, with sections Layout:

logically arranged for easy readability.

Incorporate relevant visual elements (e.g., photographs, diagrams) to Visual Elements:

enhance understanding and engagement.

Use clear, legible fonts with appropriate sizes for headings, subheadings, Font and Size:

and body text. Ensure readability from a distance.

Color Scheme: Choose a visually appealing color scheme that complements the content

and enhances overall readability.

Ensure that graphics and images are of high quality and effectively Graphics:

support the content of your poster.

Include logos or branding elements associated with your institution or Branding:

research group, if applicable.
